

*Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA):*

Through public education programs, Emergency Managers in Wisconsin counties are required to make the public aware of certain hazardous materials located at local facilities. Information about these facilities is shared with the public through the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC). The LEPC consists of representatives from a cross-section of individuals from throughout Jackson County. Types of material, quantities stored and their inherent dangers are discussed during quarterly LEPC meetings. Facilities having these hazardous materials are required to give this information to Emergency Management and to prepare written plans to respond to possible spills.
