THE PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED PLAN:

The Farmland Preservation Plan is to help provide guidance for use of agriculture and rural lands while trying to minimize conflicts between farm and non-farm land uses. The intent of this plan is to meet the minimum requirements of Chapter 91 of Wisconsin State Statutes as well as to provide information to assist in the preservation of farmland and agriculture related businesses in Jackson County.

The Farmland Preservation Plan will be referenced and coordinated with the Jackson County Comprehensive Plan as an addendum, which meets the minimum requirements of Section 66.10001 (1)(a) and 66.1001 (2) of Wisconsin State Statutes.
