DESIGNATED SPECIES TO BE CUT: Cut all stems down to 2 inches. Do not cut green marked trees.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Cut designated trees with one or more 100" sticks (pulp), or with one or more 8' 6" logs (saw).
2. Minimum top diameters are as follows: Pulpwood – 4", Conifer Logs – 9", Hardwood Logs – 11".
3. The following non-merchantable trees must be cut down to a 2" diameter to help achieve the sale objective:
Aspen, red maple, and white birch
4. All stumps shall be no higher than the stump diameter, or 10 inches, whichever is less.
5. Do not fell any standing dead trees unless they pose a safety risk.

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
