

Ch. 17.34 C-1 Resource Conservancy District

Primary district for limited development for maintaining open space and recreational uses.

Permitted uses: 17.34

- Fishing and hunting
- Preservation of scenic, historic and scientific areas
- Public fish hatcheries
- Water retention
- Public park and campground
- Soil and water conservation
- Sustained yield forestry
- Stream bank and lakeshore protection
- Floodplain
- Wildlife preserves

Conditional uses: (requires a conditional use permit)

- Drainage
- Water measurement and control facilities
- Grazing
- Truck farming
- Hunting or fishing lodge accessory structures
- Orchards
- Wild crop harvesting

Requirements for location and size of structures:

None permitted, except those housing essential services accessory to the principal or conditional uses including temporary or permanent residential structures.

Uses Prohibited:

Any uses shall not involve the dumping, filling, cultivation, mineral, soil or peat removal or any other use that would disturb the natural fauna, flora, watercourses, water regimen or topography.

Livestock: 17.40 (3)

Not Permitted unless a conditional use permit has been granted.
