

Permit Conditions and Provisions

Pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes, this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall take precedence over any conflicting reference.

1. The work shall be performed without danger to or interference with traffic using the highway.
2. All operations shall be performed without closing any highway traffic lane except as may be specifically sanctioned by authorized representatives of the governmental agency maintaining the highway. Unless otherwise authorized, full two-way traffic shall be maintained at all times. Signs, which conform in design and location to the specifications and details in the current Wisconsin Manual of Traffic Control Devices, shall be erected and in place at all times while operations are in progress which effect traffic. Such signing shall be supplemented by proper barricades, lights and/or flag persons when the nature of the operation or the condition of visibility are such that these further safety protections are necessary.
3. The work authorized within the limits of the highway right-of-way shall be accomplished where and as specified herein.
4. It shall be the responsibility of the permit applicant to determine the location of, and suitably protect from damage, any underground facilities already in place in the area influenced by the permitted work.
5. All disturbed highway facilities must be restored promptly. When restoration is not accomplished voluntarily, without delay, the maintaining highway authority may issue a notice setting forth a final date by which the restoration must be completed. If the applicant fails to complete the restoration within the allotted time, the maintaining highway authority may arrange for the restoration, and all resulting costs shall be the obligation of the permit applicant.
6. The entire cost of installing and maintaining the development shall be borne by the applicant.
7. Any boulders, stumps, or other debris resulting from the performance of the work shall be disposed of by completely covering or entirely removing from the highway right-of-way in a satisfactory manner. All highway surfaces, slopes, shoulders, ditches, and vegetation disturbed by the work shall be restored to prior condition.
8. Any excavations which affect the traveled portions of the highway or its shoulders shall be backfilled with suitable granular material, placed in layers of 12" or less and compacted mechanically to the density of the adjacent ground. Water flooding and the use of moisture in excess of necessity to facilitate mechanical compaction are expressly prohibited. Any subsequent settlements or heavings shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the maintaining highway authority. Temporary sheeting or shoring shall be used as necessary to prevent soil caving in trenches and tunnels.
9. Blasting within the limits of the highway right-of-way is prohibited unless specifically authorized by this permit.
10. The permitted facility may, if necessary, be altered at the expense of the applicant, its successors, or assigns to allow alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the highway as may hereafter be ordered pursuant to law. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facility shall be the obligation of the applicant.
11. The work shall be carried out in a manner satisfactory to the Highway Department as to compliance with the terms and conditions stated herein.
12. The Jackson County Highway Department reserves the right to make such changes, additions, and relocations within statutory limits on the right-of-way as may at any time be considered necessary to permit the relocation, reconstruction, widening, and maintaining of the highway, or provide proper protection to life and property on the highways.
13. The applicant, its successors, or assigns agree to hold harmless the Jackson County Highway Department and its duly appointed agents and employees against any action for personal injury or property damage by reason or exercise of this permit.
