

CHILD SUPPORT

In Wisconsin child support is calculated using a set of guidelines published in the Wisconsin Administrative Code. These guidelines are found in Chapter DWD 40. There are helpful links that will answer many of your questions by starting at <https://dcf.wisconsin.gov/cs/home>

In general, the guidelines require a person paying child support to pay a flat fee based on a percentage of their gross monthly income (income before deductions) as child support. The guidelines are:

- 17% for one child
- 25% for two children
- 29% for three children
- 31% for four children
- 34% for five or more children

DWD 40 provides formulas for calculating child support for situations where all the children live with one parent, where they spend substantial time with both parents, or where each parent has some of the children.
