RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FIREWOOD CUTTING ON COUNTY LAND

1. Only dead or downed wood may be cut.
2. This permit may be immediately canceled or revoked for any given reason by oral or written notice to the permittee.
 1. Permittee will use the wood for own use and shall not sell the wood.
 2. All chainsaws must be equipped with a factory installed OEM spark arrestor.
 3. Firewood cutting permits are not valid during extremely high fire danger. It is the responsibility of the permittee to check fire danger ratings with the DNR.
4. **No felling of dead trees is allowed between April 1 and July 15.** To reduce the spread of oak wilt.
5. Recommended practices for storing oak wilt infected firewood would be:
 - Debark oak wilt infected firewood before stacking,
 - Completely cover ranks of oak wilt infected firewood with 4 mil plastic and seal around the edge by covering with soil, etc. Keep covered for 1 year.
8. Permittee indemnifies and holds Jackson County from any claim, damages or liability resulting from any action or inaction of the permittee, employees or agents.
9. Rutting is not allowed on County Forest land.
10. No use of ATV's, UTV's or tractors are allowed on County Forest land.
