Crimestoppers Start Up Fees

11 member board of directors. P3 application or platform. Allows people to submit tips via online or smartphone app. Other counties in our area are using it. The cost is \$1200 per year. 1st year there is a \$250 installation fee. Board would like to split the cost with Ho-Chunk Nation, Black River Falls PD, and County which would be \$483.33 per agency. Would like to try for one year and then reassess. Will look at the traffic maintenance contracts or another traffic line item within the budget for 2020. Additional costs include insurance, phone line, tip rewards, advertising etc. Also looking at website and Facebook page. Motion by Amo 2nd by Carney to approve the \$483.33 costs for the P3 platform usage. All in favor; motion carried.

Crimestoppers Program Update

Anticipated start date to be up and fully running within the next month or two. Fundraising meeting scheduled for next week.

Shelter Quarterly Report

4th quarter and annual report presented.

Dive Team Quarterly Report

No change at this point. Still at a standstill.

Divisional Reports

Written reports presented. TSS report will be distributed. Discussion regarding building permit violations. SRD caseload has increased some due to truancy issues in the Black River Falls Schools as well as vaping and sexting issues. Will be presenting an ordinance change to the county ordinance regarding habitual truancy. Animal problems are still increased.

Resolution for Overtime Pay Under Mutual Aid, Assist Another Agency or Grant Reimbursement

To allow exempt salaried employees to receive time and half compensation pay for a reimbursable event that would not have an impact on county funds due to 100% reimbursement including fringe benefits. Hours are paid through payroll and reimbursed in offsetting revenue line for reimburse from others. Motion by Amo 2nd by Funmaker. All in favor; motion carried. Forward to Exec and Finance.

Resolution for Sergeant Wage Differential

Compression between union employees and non-union command staff that supervises them. Presented as \$1.00 per hour for Sergeants/Lieutenants above highest paid detective/deputy and \$2.00 per hour for patrol/jail Captain. For the first year of contract possibility to implement July 1 and then in budget for January 1. Would like to have additional increases covered from contingency for the 1st year then budgeted annually through Sheriff's Office budget. Tabled to February meeting for further discussion regarding implementation plan.



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Bosch Camera Failure/ SGTS 5 Year Bosch Camera Conversion Contract

Between December 19th and December 31st the oldest cameras in the system went down. Needed to convert the cameras. Believe total cost was \$46,159 we will use funds through capital equipment, jail assessment to help offset the costs but will need additional funds. As of right now we have live feed but not enough storage space to store the video.

Review 2020 Squad Bids/Authorize 2020 Purchase of Squads

Bids received from Ewalds, Brenengen, Gross and Osseo. Costs increased. Dodge Charger didn't change. 3 patrol and one unmarked. Looking at 3 patrol Dodge Chargers and then see what is left for the 4th unmarked. Motion by Ransom 2nd by Amo to negotiate for 3 2020 Dodge Charger police package vehicles from Gross Motors. 4th undecided at this time. All in favor; Motion carried.

Staff Vacancies and Recruitment Updates

Jail – Jail Sergeant position internal/external application deadline has been extended. One FTE starting 1/22/2020. Hiring process going on currently. Have tested 7 and 3 or 4 more to test for LTE.

Patrol – still struggling finding applicants. LTE Deputy Oates has been hired to fill the FT vacancy created by resignation of Deputy Kozelek who went to ATF. Recruitment is still open for patrol. Looking at strategies for recruiting LTE's.

Communications – Full staffed for FTE. Need some additional LTEs to fill in for sick calls. Will be opening hiring process for LTE Communications.
