OWI cases are still up and calls keep coming in through dispatch. SRD has been making home visits with anyone the schools have advised they are having problems with keeping in contact with.

Staff Vacancies and Recruitment Updates

Interviews for Chief Deputy position is Thursday. LTE is sworn able to carry weapon. Interns will not carry firearms.

Two part time communications officers will start next Wednesday. Revamping FTO training and going to provide scenario-based classroom training prior to being in the dispatch center. Hopeful this will help with training when they get into the dispatch center.

Jail – part time starting. Will need to fill a work comp injury.

Covid-19 Updates

Amo asked if patrol had received the PPE. Captain has advised received 40 disposable masks, one shield, and gloves from EM. Have received about 150 disposable masks from Taser Rep. The N95 masks we received were the disposable ones. Have also received hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes from school/community donations. We don't have the supplies to mask with every contact. Any inmates that are brought to jail are quarantined and kept separate from other inmates.

Vouchers Payable

IAmResponding is the notification system used for EMS. Reimbursed by local EMS agencies. Will be switching to Diamond Pharmacy and will have reduced inmate pharmacy costs. Will not be having the annual K9/Boys and Girls fundraiser this year. Hopefully we will have our ChickenQ in November. Rooster Andy's will be setting up a stand at Theisen's weekly on Fridays and will donate 10-15% to K9 Program. Motion by Amo 2nd by Funmaker to approve vouchers. All in favor; motion carried.

Budget Review

Mutual Aid lines are not budgeted but are reimbursable from grants and contracted services so it should be offset to have minimal impact. None of the new vehicles are here yet.
