October 19, 2020: Committee Meeting and Public Hearings

Meeting called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Hoyt Strandberg, Zoning and Land Information Committee Chairman. Committee members in attendance are Hoyt Strandberg, Norm Stoker, Ed Chamberlain, and Alton Staff. Others present were Terry Schmidt, Zoning Administrator; Cody Brommerich, County Surveyor; April Schoolcraft, Real Property Lister; Joe Pilkington, GIS and 911 Coordinator; and Beth Storlie, Administrative Assistant.

A Motion by Alton Staff, to approve the minutes of September 21, 2020, seconded by Norm Stoker. Motion carried.

A Motion by Ed Chamberlain, to approve the vouchers for payment, seconded by Alton Staff. Motion carried.

CSM EASEMENT REVIEW:

- Real Land Survey is completing a land division for Renee Jaime. They are dividing the parcel into three lots and a proposed 66-foot easement would allow access to lots 2 & 3 along the east property line.

A Motion by Ed Chamberlain, to approve a 66-foot easement for Renee Jaime, seconded by Norm Stoker. Motion carried.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT, Cody Brommerich:

- *PLSS Update: Remonumentation efforts are going very well. We have already completed Albion, are very near completion in Melrose, and have about 20-25 corners left in T21N-R4W.*
- *Road work is completed, and we have road corners to reset in Irving, Manchester, Garfield and Knapp. We will do this once it gets closer to gun season so we can stay out of the woods around that time.*
- *Aerial Imagery Update: The 6 inch images have been completed and delivered to us and are now on the county web mapping site.*

Ayres is working on the 3 inch deliverables. I spoke with Ayres and they are projecting we will have those delivered to us just before the end of the year.

- *Strategic Initiative Grant: 2nd Half - We will be receiving the second \$20,000 grant sometime in the next month. Received news that the 2021 strategic initiative grant will be back up to \$50,000 instead of the \$40,000, which was this year award level.*
- *2021 Grant Applications: April, Joe and myself are going to begin working on the 2021 grant applications this week.*
