

What is a ***C.S.A** farm? A Community Supported Agriculture Farm means farm members purchase "shares" of the farm at the beginning of the growing season. CSA farm members receive in-season, locally grown, fruits and/or vegetables throughout growing season. The type of produce received varies from farm to farm. Some farms will deliver all boxes to a central location for pick-up by members, while others require members to pick up their boxes at the farm. The "share" model allows a farmer to know how much produce to grow each season, and helps "share" some of the high costs that come during the beginning of the growing season. Many CSAs will offer events at the farm during the growing season, giving shareholders the opportunity to visit the farm.
