Cut all merchantable and non-merchantable trees down to 2" DBH except white pine. Cut all white pine 3 pulp sticks or larger. Do Not cut green marked or dead trees.

CUTTING SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Cut designated trees with one or more 100" sticks (pulp), or with one or more 8' 6" logs (saw).
2. Minimum top diameters are as follows: Pulpwood – 4", Hardwood Logs – 11" Pine Logs – 9".
3. All stumps shall be no higher than the stump diameter, or 10 inches, whichever is less.

5. There is an old logging camp in harvest area (see map). Contractor will be allowed to cut trees in this area but must not operate on earthen berms or pits. Contractor must notify the County in advance of harvest and be shown camp area before harvest commences.






