Divisional Reports

Technical Support Specialist (TSS) Monthly Activity Report:

- Still having problems with Tracs & Spillman not communicating correctly. Getting close to be fixed. Have made some changes waiting to see if it is working.
- CallWorks just pushed an update on Monday to fix the mapping issue dispatch was having. GIS will update districts for first responder districts.
- SGTS waiting to schedule a time to finish the interview rooms and install Genetec upgrade.
- FirstNet: Has approached us about switching to their network. They are in the process of putting up towers in Jackson County and all our neighboring counties which will increase our coverage areas.

Ho-Chunk Nation Cooperative County/Tribal Law Enforcement Agreement

Only thing added was enforcement of Ho-Chunk Nation laws and ordinances requiring information about offending Tribal Members residing on Ho-Chunk Nation trust lands shall be referred to the Ho-Chunk Nation Department of Justice/Police Department for prosecution in Ho-Chunk Tribal Court. Motion by Amo 2nd by Carney to approve the agreement and forward resolution to Exec & Finance for signature where LEC members will sign as well. All in favor; motion carried.



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Acquisition of Peace Maker – ERT Team

Armored type van from Rusk County that they are willing to give us. Sheriff's Office will be getting rid of the blue Chevy truck and will be replacing that with this vehicle. There will be no cost for us to acquire this and Rusk County will be delivering it to us. Will put out to county departments to see if there is any interest in the blue truck. Will also be selling the white cube van.

2020 Budget Discussion

Budget was turned in September 6th. Discussion took place; Jeff Amo asked if need be, could the Sheriff's Office budget be reduced by 2%? Sheriff will look into it.
