RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FIREWOOD CUTTING PERMIT ON COUNTY LAND

1. Only dead and downed wood may be cut.
2. This permit maybe be immediately canceled or revoked for any reason by oral or written notice to the permittee.
3. Permittee will use the wood for their own use and not sell the wood.
4. All chainsaws must be equipped with a factory installed OEM spark arrestor
5. Firewood permits are not valid during extremely high fire danger. It is the responsibility of the permittee to check fire danger levels with DNR before cutting.
6. NO FELLING OF DEAD TREES IS ALLOWED BETWEEN APRIL 1 AND JULY 15 TO REDUCE THE SPREAD OF OAK WILT.
7. Recommended practices for storing oak wilt infected firewood are:
 - a. Debark oak wilt infected firewood before stacking.
 - b. Cover firewood with 4 mil plastic and seal around edges. Keep covered 1 year.
8. Permittee indemnifies and holds Jackson County from any claim, damage or liability resulting from the action or in action of the employee, permittee or agents
9. Rutting is not allowed on county forest land.
10. No use of ATV, UTVS or tractors are allowed on county forest land.
